RE: Notification of Tritium Sign Disposal

Dear Ms. Haney,

As per 10 CFR 31.5, please accept this letter as notification of the upcoming shipment of these tritium-containing signs.

Kodiak Electric Association, Inc. removed seven (7) tritium exit signs from our headquarters building located at 515 East Marine Way in Kodiak, Alaska. All of these signs were manufactured by Brandhurst Inc. (USNRC License No. 31-20726-02G), and are being shipped to SRB Technologies, Inc. (NC Radioactive Materials License# 034-0534-2) for proper disposal.

The listed serial numbers for each unit are as follows:

The sign label indicates that the maximum tritium content of each sign is 25 curies.
