Dear Ms. Gavutis:

I am writing regarding the petition that you submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated November 28, 2008. There were two remaining requests in your petition that the NRC reserved for future rulemaking determination:

- 1) Require that dry casks are qualified for transport at the time of onsite storage approval certification, and
- 2) Require a safe and secure hot cell transfer station coupled with an auxiliary pool to be built as part of an upgraded independent spent fuel storage installation design certification and licensing process.

The NRC staff has been evaluating the remaining two issues for a rulemaking determination and is now ready to resolve these issues. You will be notified by a subsequent letter every 6 months on the status of the petition or the agency's final decision, whichever comes first.
