Dear Chairman Burns:


Four years has passed since the Fukushima tragedy (not accident) happened and its effects still roils Japan.

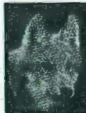
The Indian Point reactors are not far from where I live. The ideal situation would be to deny the owner from operating these reactors forever.
