SUBJECT: Information related to establishing Standby Status

The licensee requested standby status since they are not using licensed material for medical use at the present time (they are trying to get radiopharmacies to re-establish deliveries of material to St. Croix) and needed to assign a Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Scott K. Brinkerhoff was chosen to perform this function as he is already doing it for Governor Juan F. Luis and his qualifications are on file in the document with ascension number ML15012A428. The date of their last patient was in March of 2013 and they disposed of their last generator in June of 2013. I discussed with Cherie Crisden in Enforcement whether the disposal of the generator was considered a principal activity. We both agreed that this was considered a principal activity so the expiration date on the license was set at June 30, 2015 or 24 months from the date of last principal activity. I will call the RSO and inform him of the option in 10 CFR 30.36(f) to request an exemption to the time periods established in 10 CFR 30.36(d).
