Dear Mr. Hemann:

This refers to your application dated October 6, 2014, requesting the renewal of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Exempt Distribution License. Please find enclosed the NRC exempt distribution License No. 24-23912-02E amendment no. 02

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all the conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please contact me so that appropriate corrections or answers can be provided.

Please be advised that you must manufacture and distribute the products in accordance with the statements and representations contained in your application, with enclosures thereto, and the information set out in your license and registration certificate. As a general rule, you must request and obtain an amendment to the license and registration certificate before you make changes or modifications to the information submitted to obtain them. You are also obligated to notify us promptly in writing should you decide to no longer distribute the product.

Please be advised that you must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions specified in your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and other rules, regulations, and orders of the NRC, now or hereafter in effect, to include the following:

1. Comply with applicable NRC regulations in 10 CFR Part 30, "Rules of General Applicability to Domestic Licensing of Byproduct Material"; 10 CFR Part 32, "Specific Domestic Licenses to Manufacture or Transfer Certain Items Containing Byproduct Material"; and other applicable regulations.

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2. Distribute only those products containing radioactive material which are specifically authorized in your license.
3. Notify NRC in writing within 30 days of any change in mailing address.
4. In accordance with 10 CFR 30.33, 30.34 and 30.38, please file appropriate documentation with the NRC prior to any changes to your organization, change locations of distribution of products containing radioactive material, facilities, equipment, procedures, change in the contact person or the person responsible for the quality assurance program for licensed activities, or any other changes in your program which are contrary to the license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with the NRC.
5. Submit a complete renewal application or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You should receive a reminder notice approximately 60 days before the expiration date. Continued distribution of products containing radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
6. In accordance with 10 CFR 30.36, request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving distribution of products containing radioactive material.

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Please be aware that, as a holder of an NRC registration, you may be subject to the NRC's licensing and inspection fees in accordance with 10 CFR Part 170, and annual fees in accordance with 10 CFR Part 171.
