SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MARCH 24, 2015, CATEGORY 2 PUBLIC
MEETING WITH THE NUCLEAR ENERGY INSTITUTE TO DISCUSS
LOCAL INTENSE PRECIPITATION WARNING TIME WHITE PAPER
ASSOCIATED WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF JAPAN LESSONS-
LEARNED NEAR-TERM TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATION 2.1,
FLOODING

On March 24, 2015¹, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) at NRC Headquarters, Two White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss staff comments on NEI's white paper², "Warning Time for Maximum Precipitation Events" related to the flooding hazard reevaluations associated with the implementation of Recommendation 2.1, Flooding of the March 12, 2012, NRC request for information issued pursuant to Title 10 to the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 50, Section 50.54(f) (hereafter referred to as the 50.54(f) letter³).

During the meeting Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) representatives discussed technical details of the proposed white paper which provides guidance for establishing warning time for a local intense precipitation event.
