By letter dated October 28, 1997, Duke Energy submitted an amendment request to convert to Improved Technical Specifications. By letter dated October 28, 1998, Duke Energy submitted Supplement 4 to the ITS submittal. This Supplement incorporated changes that resulted from discussions between Duke Energy and the Staff in relation to ITS sections 3.3, 3.8 and 5.0. By letter dated December 16, 1998, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment 300, 300, and 300 to Facility Operating Licenses DPR-38, DPR-47, and DPR-55, for the Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2 and 3, respectively.

Supplement 4 also incorporated Amendment 232, 232, and 231 to Facility Operating Licenses DPR-38, DPR-47, and DPR-55, for the Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2 and 3, respectively. This amendment was issued by NRC by letter dated September 4, 1998. This amendment completely revised the current Technical Specifications (TS) related to the electrical distribution system and incorporated new requirements for system operation, limiting conditions for operation, and surveillance requirements. The amendment included a new CHANNEL CALIBRATION (SR 3.7.6.1) for the Emergency Power

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
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Switching Logic (EPSL) voltage sensing channels with a setpoint allowable value for 230 kV switchyard degraded grid voltage of ≥ 226 kV and ≤ 229 kV. The allowable value approved in Amendment 232, 232, and 231 was not carried over into the ITS when supplemented after this amendment due to a transcription error. As a result, the allowable value in the ITS as issued in Amendment 300, 300, and 300 is incorrect and should be replaced with the allowable value that was approved in Amendment 232, 232, and 231. Duke hereby requests that NRC re-issue the TS page in which the error occurs to include the correct setpoint allowable value. This corrected page is included in Enclosure 1 to this letter.

Re-issuance of this page is requested by March 25, 1999 to support the planned ITS implementation date of March 27, 1999.
