By letter dated July 6, 1998, Duke Energy Corporation submitted an Application for Renewed Operating Licenses for Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2, and 3 (Application) which provided information as required by 10 CFR Part 54. During the staff review of the Application, Duke Energy is required by §54.21(b) to report changes to the current licensing basis in the following manner:

§54.21(b) CLB changes during NRC review of the application. Each year following submittal of the license renewal application and at least 3 months before the scheduled completion of the NRC review, an amendment to the renewal application must be submitted that identifies any change to the CLB of the facility that materially affects the contents of the license renewal application, including the FSAR supplement.

To comply with this requirement, Duke Energy intends to submit a single amendment to the Oconee Application on or about September 30, 1999. Duke Energy believes that this single amendment meets the requirements and intent of §54.21(b), in that the submittal date of the amendment (1) is in the first year following the submittal of the Application and (2) is more than three months before the scheduled completion of the NRC review (currently February 12, 2000 as reported in NRC letter to Duke Energy dated July 31, 1998).

The submittal of a single amendment on or about September 30, 1999 would also parallel the submission of Duke Energy comments on the staff's safety evaluation report, which is currently scheduled for transmittal on or about October 15, 1999. Providing the single amendment required by §54.21(b) and Duke Energy comments on the safety evaluation report in approximately the same time period will result in an effective and efficient use of resources by Duke Energy and the NRC.
