Response to Generic Letter 96-01
Completion of Requested Actions

Generic Letter 96-01 (GL 96-01), dated January 10, 1996, requested holders of operating licenses to supply information to the NRC regarding testing of safety related logic circuits. Duke provided its initial response to GL 96-01 in a letter dated April 17, 1996. This initial response defined the scope of the systems that were included in the GL 96-01 review program. In addition, the initial response included the schedules for completing the review and submitting future responses to the NRC. Consistent with the required response of GL 96-01 and the schedule communicated in Duke's initial response, the purpose of this letter is to confirm the completion of the requested actions of GL 96-01 for Oconee Nuclear Units 1, 2, and 3.

The review program that was recently completed on the Oconee units did identify some portions of the affected logic circuitry where the station Technical Specifications were not being fulfilled. However, the necessary corrective actions were completed for these cases and operability was confirmed within the allowable times of the existing Technical Specifications. A review of these cases indicated that no reportability actions were required.

In addition, the review program identified areas where the logic circuitry testing program could possibly be enhanced. Oconee has completed the required actions necessary to implement the identified enhancements.
