Supplement to Amendment 23

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3), Amendment 23 to the Duke Energy Corporation Topical Report *Duke-1-A, Quality Assurance Program* (Topical Report) was submitted to the NRC by Duke letter dated April 8, 1998. Based upon recent telephone conversations with NRC officials and an internal organizational change, Duke is hereby submitting revised information for inclusion in Amendment 23 (which is presently undergoing NRC review). The proposed changes to Amendment 23 are administrative in nature and are described in the following paragraphs.

Topical Report pages 17-20 and 17-21 (which are Figures 17-2 and 17-3) are included in this supplement and are shown in marked format in Attachment 1 of this letter. The new proposed pages are shown in Attachment 2 of this letter. The revision of these figures clarifies that the Duke Corporate Nuclear Safety Review Board reports to the Executive Vice President, Nuclear Generation.

This supplement to Amendment 23 also contains a change to the Nuclear General Office (NGO) organization as described in Section 17.3.1.2.2 of the Topical Report. One of the NGO divisions has undergone a recent name change. The former NGO Station Support Division is now designated as the Nuclear Services Division. This change is also shown on Pages 17-20 and 17-21. Additionally, this



change affects the text of Section 17.3.1.2.2 as shown on Page 17-15. This text has been revised to change the division name and to eliminate human performance as a organizational unit of the Nuclear Services Division. The human performance function has been integrated into the overall responsibilities of the Nuclear Services Division. Page 17-15 is also included in Attachment 1 and Attachment 2.

The organizational changes described in this supplement to Amendment 23 are administrative in nature and have been determined to not reduce Duke's current quality related commitments. It is requested that this supplement be added to the contents of the April 8 submittal and that the NRC complete its review of Amendment 23 in a timely manner.
