Dear Dr. Marcus:

This letter is in reference to your petition for rulemaking (PRM) that you submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on February 9, 2015 (NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML15051A503). You request that the NRC amend Part 20 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," based on new science and evidence that contradicts the Linear No-Threshold (LNT) hypothesis. In addition, on May 16, 2015, you submitted to the NRC an additional reference providing technical information supporting your requests.

The NRC has determined that the petition meets the threshold sufficiency requirements for a petition for rulemaking under § 2.802, "Petition for rulemaking," and the petition has been docketed. Your petition has been assigned Docket No. PRM-20-28 and Docket ID NRC-2015-0057. Please reference this Docket No. and Docket ID on any correspondence you may have concerning your petition.

The NRC has received two additional petitions on the same topic (PRM-20-29 and PRM-20-30); action on all three petitions will be conducted using the same Docket ID (NRC-2015-0057). The enclosed notice acknowledging docketing of the petitions will be published in the *Federal Register*, and a citation to the additional reference that you submitted to the NRC is included in this document. The NRC is requesting public comment on the petitions at this time. As the staff reviews your petition, it may be necessary to request additional information.
