CERTIFICATE AS TO PARTIES, RULINGS AND RELATED CASES

Pursuant to D.C. Circuit Rules 15(c)(3) and 28(a)(1), counsel for Petitioner

Missouri Coalition for the Environment ("Missouri Coalition") certifies as follows:

1. Parties, Intervenor, and *Amici Curiae*.

Petitioner is Missouri Coalition for the Environment. Respondents are the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") and the United States of America. Currently, there are no other parties to the case.

2. Rulings Under Review

Petitioner seeks review of the following NRC decisions related to the renewal of the operating license for the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1:

- NRC Commission Memorandum and Order CLI-15-11 (Apr. 23, 2015) (“Memorandum and Order CLI-15-11”) (Attachment 1 to Petition for Review);
- License Renewal for Callaway Plant, Unit 1, 80 Fed. Reg. 13,636 (Mar. 16, 2015) (“License Renewal Decision”) (Attachment 2 to Petition for Review); and
- NRC Commission Memorandum and Order CLI-15-04 (Feb. 26, 2015) (“Memorandum and Order CLI-15-04”) (Attachment 3 to Petition for Review).

3. Related Cases

This case is related to *State of New York v. NRC*, Nos. 14-1210, 14-1212, 14-1216, and 14-1217 (Consolidated) (filed Oct. 29, 2014), in the respects that (a) Missouri Coalition is a party to *State of New York* and (b) both cases concern the same facts and legal issues under the Atomic Energy Act, the National Environmental Policy Act, and the Administrative Procedures Act. In *State of New York*, the petitioners (including Missouri Coalition) seek review of the NRC’s Continued Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel Rule, 70 Fed. Reg. 56,238 (Sept. 19, 2014) (“Rule”) and the NRC’s Generic Environmental Impact Statement for the Continued Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel, 70 Fed. Reg. 56,263 (Sept. 19, 2014)

("GEIS"). The NRC issued the Rule and GEIS on remand from this Court's decision in *State of New York v. NRC*, 681 F.3d 471 (D C. Cir. 2012).

In this case, Missouri Coalition seeks review of the NRC's License Renewal Decision and Memorandum and Order on the grounds that they rely on the Rule and the GEIS now on appeal to this Court in *State of New York*. The Court's ruling in *State of New York* will resolve all of this issues raised in this petition for review, and therefore Missouri Coalition has moved the Court to hold this case in abeyance pending the Court's ruling in *State of New York*.
