**SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION APPROVAL OF AGILENT
TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC
DISCLOSURE**

Dear Mr. Hoppy:

Agilent Technologies, Inc. submitted an affidavit dated March 20, 2015, executed by Jeanne M. Breitigan, requesting that the information contained in drawings B-0905-9006-1, C-G2397-20500-1, G2397-20510, G2397-20550, G4593-20002, G4593-20532, G4593-60300, and document titled ECD Model G4597A, submitted in connection with your response to NRC Request for Additional Information (RAI) dated March 19, 2015, for the Models G4597A and G4598A be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure because (1) Agilent Technologies, Inc. is the sole owner of the information contains provided in the documents listed above, and (2) is the type of information that is valuable to the competitors of Agilent Technologies and is considered as a potential loss of market share.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 9.17 and 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, Agilent Technologies, Inc. documents included in your response to NRC's RAI dated March 19, 2015, will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 9.17 and 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the
