This refers to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License Number 19-31447-01, Docket No. 03038471, Control No. 585379, concerning an April 15, 2015 meeting conducted via telephone conversation between Messrs. Craig S. Goldberg, Barry J. Silber, Michael S. Gray, Hugo Bianchi, Burton C. Cummings, Gary R. Ziola, and Marcos S. Vicente of our staff; Ms. Kristina V. McCarthy-Martin, U.S. Army Materiel Command; Mr. Gregory R. Komp, Department of the Army Safety; and Mr. Robert Gattone and Ms. Kathleen D. Modes of your Commission. The subject of the meeting was the recent inspection involving the U.S. Property and Fiscal Office (USP&FO), 7001 Range Road, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101-1203.

During the referenced April 15, 2015 telephone conversation, Mr. Gattone reported that we did not meet the requirements of the Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30.36 (10 CFR 30.36) for an APD 2000, Serial Number 2017. This device was in storage for over 24 months and we did not notify the Commission in writing within 60 days of the occurrence as required by 10 CFR 30.36(d).

Reason for the violation: It was not our understanding that storage is not considered a principal activity for this license.

Corrective steps taken and results achieved:

- a. We are notifying you in writing that two devices at the above location under this license have exceeded the 24 month time period:
  - o APD 2000, SN 2017 (contains 10 millicuries of Nickel-63)
  - o Viewing Set, Night Vision, National Stock Number 5855-01-093-3080 (contains 1 microcurie of Thorium-232)
- b. We are requesting you to extend the time periods established in 10 CFR 30.36(d) per 10 CFR 30.36(f) for items stored at this USP&FO.



c. Personnel at the storage location have initiated the process for disposal action. Further, these items are stored internally to the USP&FO, which is a controlled facility. There is no risk to the health and safety of the public for continued storage of these items until their ultimate disposal.

Additional corrective steps to be taken to avoid further violations. We are requesting an amendment to this license to add the storage of all radioactive material authorized under this license as a principal activity.

With the implementation of the above corrective actions and the issuance of license amendment to add storage as a principal activity, we will be in full compliance with this requirement of the license. Please let us know if you have questions or require clarification on any of the above.
