The Commission is being asked to act on a memorandum and order responding to petitions to intervene filed by co-owners of the Seabrook Station Unit One and Millstone Station Unit Three facilities.

New England Power Company seeks the Commission's approval of a transaction under which the New England Electric System, of which New England Power Company is a wholly-owned subsidiary, would itself become a wholly-owned subsidiary of the National Red Group PLC, a company incorporated under the laws of England and Wales.

The petitioners are challenging New England Power Company's financial qualifications and indirect foreign ownership.

The Commission has voted to approve a memorandum
