Dear Mr. Gilbert:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is returning without further action the application XB1332/01 (enclosed) for a license amendment to extend the expiration date and change the licensee's point of contact. License XB1332 expired on February 28, 2015, and no longer authorizes the export of material to Iraq.

The reason for the return, as discussed in the enclosed email exchanges, is that the NRC determined it was necessary to raise the review level of your application from the original minor amendment to the Executive Branch review level due to the current security situation in Iraq. Consequently, the processing fee increased from \$1,400 to \$9,800, and you elected not to go forward with the application process.

As the NRC had already started processing the application, we cannot refund your licensing fee submitted for \$1,400. If you have further questions regarding this application, please contact Jane Chimood at (301) 415-1575.

### § 170.12 Payment of fees.

(a) **Application and registration fees.** Each application or registration for which a fee is prescribed must be accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of the fee. The NRC will not issue a new license or an amendment increasing the scope of an existing license to a higher fee category before receiving the prescribed application fee. The application or registration fee(s) is charged whether the Commission approves the application or not. The application or registration fee(s) is also charged if the applicant withdraws the application or registration.

(b) **Licensing fees.**

(1) Licensing fees will be assessed to recover full costs for—

- (i) The review of applications for new licenses and approvals;
- (ii) The review of applications for amendments to and renewal of existing licenses or approvals;
- (iii) Preapplication consultations and reviews; and
- (iv) The full cost for project managers assigned to a specific plant or facility, excluding leave time and time spent on generic activities (such as rulemaking).

This is to inform you that, after much consideration, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has determined to raise your export license amendment application XB1332/01 from minor amendment to the Executive Branch review level, due to the current uncertain security situation in Iraq. The processing fee for an Executive Branch review level application is \$9,800.
