Good morning,

Do you realize how hard it is to get (very) good basic equipment knowledge?

About 1988 EPRI made available a set of about 17 booklets on specific topics. You were able to request two sets. I did that and gave the two sets out when I got them. Then I requested two sets, received them, handed them out, and, requested two more. Well, that worked 6 or 7 times before we were told we were only entitled to two sets, which, of course, we had received already.

Unfortunately, I never got to the point of keeping a set for myself. However, I did manage to borrow at least some and read them. I found them extremely informative.

I am recommending that each NRC resident inspecting team, (at each operating plant site), be provided with one set for reference. I also think that there should be one set within arm's reach of the EDO. And, I think that each staff for each Commissioner and the staff for the Chairman should get a set as well. There should be one set in each Regional NRC office, one set for each group doing operating assessment, and there should be a set in that 24 hour a day Operations Center.
