CHAIRMAN ZECH: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen.

This is an affirmation session. I understand we have one item to bring before us this morning. Before I ask the Secretary to discuss that item, do any of my fellow Commissioners have any comments to make?

CHAIRMAN ZECH: If not, Mr. Secretary, proceed, please.

MR. CHILK: The subject is SECY 88-58, it is an order on the TMI-II leak rate proceeding. In this paper, the Commission is asked to act on an order which completes its review of the Hearing Board May 1987 decision. That considered what action should be taken concerning individuals possibly involved in falsification of reactor coolant system leak rates at TMI-II prior to the accident.

All the Commissioners have approved an order as modified by Chairman Zech and Commissioner Carr, which was attached to our Memorandum, which lifts the TMI re-start condition, prohibiting employment at TMI-I in a responsible management or operational position as it applied to all pre-accident TMI-II operators, shift supervisors, shift foremen, or other individuals except gangs employed by the pre-TMI-II supervisor of operations.

1 Commissioner Bernthal notes that while approving, he
2 would have preferred to follow the course recommended by the
3 staff in SECY 87-11, that is to continue the prohibition for
4 some operators of TMI-II who may have been implicated by recent
5 allegations of sleeping on duty.

6 Would you please affirm your votes.

7 CHAIRMAN ZECH: Aye.

8 COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.

9 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

10 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye.

11 CHAIRMAN ZECH: Anything else to come before us

13 MR. CHILK: I have nothing.

14 CHAIRMAN ZECH: We stand adjourned.
