PerkinElmer (PKI) is requesting an amendment to Exempt Distribution License #20-00320-14E concerning the name of the liquid scintillation counter currently listed in amendment 21 as the Tri-Carb model no. A6220XX series as provided in our amendment request dated March 30, 2015. Specifically (i.e. Item 9B):

- Tri-Carb Model No. A6220XX Series should be changed to Quantulus GCT A6220XX Series.

This amendment request involves an instrument name change only. None of the substantive statements made in the original amendment communication letter related to this device dated June 3, 2013, the amendment request dated March 30, 2015 or any related communications other than the instrument name model number have changed.

Distribution of the Tri-Carb model no. 3180XX series should be retained in this requested amendment.

The radioactive material identified above is possessed under State of Massachusetts License No. 56-0683. This license is also being amended to clarify the change in model numbers.
