MR. CHILK: The item, Mr. Chairman, is SECY 88-291A, entitled Shoreham Exercise Hearing. In this paper the Commission is being asked to act on an order addressing the future course of the proceeding on the 1988 emergency planning exercise for the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station.

Chairman Zech and Commissioners Roberts, Carr and Rogers have approved an order which is attached to our memorandum of November the 29th which would establish expedited procedures under which the hearing would conclude in approximately five months with a decision in approximately seven months. Commissioner Curtiss did not participate in this matter.

This order also notes that although the Commission has under review the OL-3 Board's dismissal of the intervenors in LBP-88-24, the Commission believes it is prudent to establish procedures and go forward with any necessary proceedings on the 1988 exercise, at least pending the Commission decision on its review of LBP-88-24.

1           The matter of dismissal of intervenors as parties will  
2 be addressed by a separate order at a later date.

3           Would you please affirm your votes.

4           CHAIRMAN ZECH: Aye.


