Dear Dr. Shevitz:

In NRC Form 314 dated March 2, 2014, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate the NRC radioactive material license for A A & A Medical, NRC License No. 21-32818-01. In your NRC Form 314, you confirmed that all residual licensed material has been removed from the locations of use – 29600 Northwestern Highway, Suite #106, Southfield, Michigan, and 29829 Telegraph Road, Suite L102, Southfield, Michigan, listed on the A A & A Medical Co. license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of 10 CFR Part 20, Subpart E, and is ALARA.

You listed Ray Carlson, Consultant, as the designated contact person regarding the request. We called Mr. Carlson concerning his knowledge and understanding of any residual licensed material at the licensee's facilities listed above. In letter dated April 30, 2015, Mr. Carlson indicated that he removed all residual sealed sources from the licensee's facilities and found no other radioactive material or contamination. Leak tests demonstrating that sources removed from A A & A medical's facilities were not leaking were enclosed with Mr. Carlson's letter.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the A A & A Medical Co. facilities located at 29600 Northwestern Highway, Suite #106, Southfield, Michigan, and 29829 Telegraph Road, Suite L102, Southfield, Michigan and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-32818-01 is hereby terminated.
