I have serious concerns that the proposed expansion of FPL's Turkey Point could significantly impact and degrade the health of our national parks, sensitive ecological areas including extensive wetlands, federally listed threatened and endangered wildlife, and the quality and quantity of limited fresh water resources. I request that both agencies support the "No Action" alternative in reference to Docket ID: NRC-2009-0337.

I am especially worried that neither FPL nor the NRC have addressed the issue of sea level rise, which has the potential to reach up to six feet by the end of this century. Tsunamis may not be as frequent as in the Pacific but they are possible in the Atlantic and storm surges can be as bad as many tsunamis. By not accounting for sea level rise along with tsunamis and storm surges we are risking another Fukushima on our own doorstep.
