Enclosed is an application (XB1329/03), dated June 2, 2015, recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from Rapiscan Systems, Inc., requesting amendment No. 03 to its existing license, XB1329/02. The license presently authorizes the export to Iraq of 1,000 explosive detection devices containing a total of 740 MBq Am-241 foil source, for demonstration to the Iraqi military.

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the date of expiration from June 30, 2015 to June 30, 2018.

There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested; therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. The NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day public review period.
