Dear Sir or Madam:

On December 3, 2014, the NRC issued a confirmatory order (Reference 1) to Entergy. Reference 1 was immediately effective and directs Entergy to complete the commitments made by Entergy as part of a settlement agreement reached during an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) mediation session conducted on September 22, 2014, in Arlington, Texas between Entergy and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The settlement agreement concerns an apparent violation of NRC security requirements as discussed in the non-public enclosures to the NRC letter dated July 16, 2014 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) ML 14198A338). The specific requirements are outlined in Attachment 1.

Reference 1 requires submission of an initial status report 60 days following issuance of the Confirmatory Order. Reference 1 also requires submission of a status report at six-month intervals following submittal of the initial status report.
