I am a lifelong resident of South Florida (71 years and counting). I have raised three children here and have been a homeowner for 36 years. The proposed expansion of the Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant has the potential to destroy, in an instant, everything I have spent my life working for.

With this fact in mind I would like to object to the plan to expand the Nuclear Power Generators at Turkey Point. Contrary to the assertion of the NRC (EIS) that the "socioeconomic" effects of building and operating the proposed reactors # 6 and # 7, are "small and beneficial" I believe the actual risk to the population of South Florida can be devastating.

History has shown that unanticipated "incidents" can occur at Nuclear Power generating facilities. History has also shown that the results of such an incident can be catastrophic and long-lasting.

Although this decision may be a means to enrich the shareholders of Florida Power and Light, it places the entire population of South Florida in jeopardy.

I hearby request that you deny the construction and operating license for the proposed facilities at Turkey Point.
