Reference US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license number SUC-1593 (docket 040-09083) issued to HQ US Army Installation Management Command for possession of residual depleted uranium (DU) at Schofield Barracks and Pohakuloa Training Area in Hawaii.

I am applying to amend the license to add Davy Crockett residual DU at Fort Benning GA, Fort Bragg NC, Fort Campbell KY, Fort Carson CO, Fort Gordon GA, Fort Greely AK, Fort Hood TX, Fort Hunter Liggett CA, Fort Jackson SC, Fort Knox KY, Fort Polk LA, Fort Riley KS, Fort Sill OK, Joint Base Lewis-McChord/Yakima Training Center WA, and Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst NJ. Consequently, I also am applying to increase the maximum possession amount of DU from 125 kilograms to 5700 kilograms.

The enclosed application consists of a new NRC Form 313 and associated documents. In a separate letter will be information supporting a categorical exclusion for possession of depleted uranium military munitions [Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 51, § 51.22(c)(14)(xv)].
