**SUBJECT: NRC APPROVAL OF LEIDOS, INC. REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING
INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE**

Dear Mr. Johanning:

Leidos Inc. submitted an affidavit dated June 3, 2015, executed by Gary Jongeward, requesting that the content of the amendment request dated May 13, 2015, regarding exempt distribution license no. 04-23994-01E, be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390. The contents of the amendment request contains information that is ITAR controlled under a contract with the U.S. Navy and/or information with Leidos is the sole owner of and this information is not available from any other public sources.

The affidavit states that Leidos is requesting to withhold proprietary information by relying on the exemption set forth in NRC Regulations 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4). This information is Leidos owned information that falls under "Trade Secrets, Commercial, Proprietary/Privileged and confidential Information." The content is consider proprietary for the following reasons: (1) The information is confidential information between Leidos and its customers or suppliers in the design and use of the device; (2) The information will allow a competitor to understand Leidos supply chain, detector techniques and geometry, and the Quality Control procedures of Leidos Production/Manufacturing business.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, Leidos, Inc. information submitted in amendment request dated May 13, 2015, will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified of the date of public disclosure, in advance which will be a reasonable time thereafter.
