

**AFFIDAVIT**

I, Gary A. Jongeward, state as follows:

1. As Vice President and Division Manager at Leidos in control of the information described in Paragraph (2). I am authorized to request it be withheld.
2. The information to be withheld is the contents of the Amendment Request dated May 13, 2015 (Mail Control No. 586848) to amend License 04-23994-01E. The contents of this request contains information that is ITAR controlled under a contract with the U.S. Navy and/or information which Leidos is the sole owner of and this information is not available from any other public sources.
3. In making this application for withholding of ITAR controlled information, Leidos relies upon the exemption from disclosure set forth in the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") and Trade Secrets Act, and the NRC Regulations 10CFR§9.17(a)(1) and (3); and §2.390(a)(1) and (3). This information is specifically exempted by ITAR statute (22CFR§120-§130). Specifically the ITAR categories that apply to the product are:

CATEGORY VI—SURFACE VESSELS OF WAR AND SPECIAL NAVAL EQUIPMENT

*(e) Naval nuclear propulsion plants, their land prototypes, and special facilities for their construction, support, and maintenance.

Leidos interprets this to include any machinery, device, component, or equipment specifically developed, designed or modified for use in such plants or facilities.

4. Further, in making this application for withholding proprietary information, Leidos relies upon the exemption set forth in NRC Regulations 10CFR§9.17(a)(4) and §2.390(a)(4). This information is Leidos owned information that falls under "Trade Secrets, Commercial, Proprietary/Privileged and Confidential Information."
5. Some Examples of information which fit in the definition of proprietary/privileged and confidential information are:
 - a. Information that discloses confidential information between Leidos and our customers or suppliers in the design and use of the device. This information is considered proprietary between Leidos and its customers and is otherwise not publically available.
 - b. Information that would allow a competitor to understand our supply chain, detector techniques and geometry, and the Quality Control procedures of Leidos Production/Manufacturing business.


If the information identified in 4a and 4b above were used by competitors, it would reduce their expenditure of resources or improve their competitive position in the design, manufacture, sales, shipment, and licensing of a similar product. The information sought to be withheld is considered to be proprietary to third parties.

6. To address 10CFR§2.390(b)(4), the information sought to be withheld is being submitted to the NRC in confidence. The information is customarily held in confidence by Leidos, is not available to the public or disclosed to third parties.

I declare that the foregoing affidavit and the information stated therein are true and correct the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.
