NRC Names New Resident Inspector at Arkansas Nuclear One



The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Margaret Tobin as the new Resident Inspector at Arkansas Nuclear One in Russellville, Ark.

“Margaret Tobin’s technical experience and regulatory perspective will assist the NRC in carrying out its mission to protect people and the environment by ensuring the safe operation of Arkansas Nuclear One,” said NRC Region IV Administrator Marc Dapas.

Tobin joined the NRC in June 2010 as a reliability and risk engineer in the Office of Research at NRC Headquarters in Rockville, Md. She joined Region IV in 2015 as a reactor engineer. She graduated from Arizona State University in Tempe, Ariz., with a bachelor’s degree in electrical engineering in 2010.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant has at least two Resident Inspectors. Tobin joins Senior Resident Inspector Brian Tindell at the site. They serve as the agency’s eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring significant work projects, and interacting with plant workers and the public.
