SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC MEETINGS FOR THE DRAFT
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT TO SUPPORT REVIEW OF
THE BELL BEND NULCEAR POWER PLANT COMBINED LICENSE
APPLICATION

On Thursday, June 4, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff, along with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Baltimore District, held two public meetings at the Bloomsburg University, Monty's Building in Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania, regarding the draft environmental impact statement (EIS) for the Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant (BBNPP) combined license (COL) application review. The purpose of the meetings was to present the findings and preliminary recommendation of the draft EIS and provide the public with an opportunity to provide comments on the EIS.

Formal presentations were made at the start of each meeting by Jennifer Dixon-Herrity, Branch Chief, Environmental Projects Branch; Tomeka Terry, Environmental Project Manager of the NRC staff; and Wade Chandler of the USACE. During each meeting, the NRC and USACE presentations outlined:

1. The NRC and USACE review processes;
2. The BBNPP environmental review schedule;
3. A summary of the contents and findings in the draft EIS including NRC's preliminary recommendation; and
4. How to access the draft EIS and provide comments on it to the NRC.

After the formal presentations were given by the staff, members of the public were invited to provide comments. Approximately 72 people attended the two meetings. Attendees included members of the public and media; representatives of the NRC and its contractor, Pacific Northwest National Laboratory; representatives from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; public interest groups; Federal, State and local government officials; and representatives from Talen Energy. The comments on the draft EIS related to radiological safety, consumptive water use, ecological impacts, alternative energy, and socioeconomic impacts. Comments received during the meetings will be reviewed and those that are within scope will be addressed in the final EIS.

In addition, the NRC staff hosted an informal open house for one hour prior to each meeting. During the open house, the NRC and USACE staff provided displays and brochures and met with members of the public to answer questions about the proposed COL application for BBNPP.
