SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC  
DISCLOSURE: TRIENNIAL DECOMMISSIONING FUNDING PLAN  
(TECHNICAL ASSIGNMENT CONTROL NUMBER L33376)

Dear Ms. Parr:

By letter (LTR-RAC-15-32) dated June 5, 2015, the Westinghouse Electric Company, LLC (Westinghouse), requested that information be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390. An affidavit stated that the information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- The information has been held in confidence by Westinghouse;
- The information is of a type customarily held in confidence by Westinghouse;
- The information was transmitted to and received by the Commission in confidence;
- The information reveals cost or price information, production capacities, budget levels, or commercial strategies of Westinghouse;
- Public disclosure of the information sought to be withheld is likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of Westinghouse, taking into account the value of the information, the amount of effort or money spent to acquire the information, and the ease with which the information could be acquired or duplicated by others.

The staff at the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) reviewed the application in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Section 2.390 and, on the basis of statements made by Westinghouse, determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary and commercial information. Therefore, the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from the public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390 and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, Westinghouse should promptly notify the NRC staff. Westinghouse should also understand that the NRC staff may have cause to review this determination in the future; for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes the subject information. In such situations, if the NRC staff makes a determination adverse to the above, Westinghouse will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
