NRC Receives High Marks for Small Business Contracting

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission received an “A” from the U.S. Small Business Administration today for its Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 efforts to meet the federal contracting goal for small businesses. This marks the fourth consecutive year the NRC has earned this recognition.

“The NRC is committed to supporting the nation's small businesses, including those owned by women and veterans, and those located in historically underutilized business zones,” said Chairman Stephen Burns. “Relying on small business products and services not only helps us accomplish our mission, but also supports local communities with jobs and economic development.”

In FY 2014, the NRC had \$245.3 million in eligible contracting dollars. Of that amount, approximately 35.5 percent went to small businesses – exceeding the agency goal of 31.5 percent.
