Dear Mr. Scott W. Claunch,

This is in reference to your letter dated May 11, 2015, responding to our request for additional information electronic mail dated May 8, 2015, concerning financial assurance for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 34-32780-02, Docket No. 03038331. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. In your response to question three, you stated that you cannot provide evidence for future changes in labor rates. We are asking that the you provide evidence that the labor rates, packing and transport costs, equipment costs, and disposal rates used in your calculation, which normally changes due to inflation, is actually the same today as the cost was submitted in your December 2011 decommissioning funding plan. Your estimate is expected to be based on today's costs and not an estimate of the cost in the future. A response could be in a form of a letter from an independent consultant stating the labor rates, packing and transport rates, and disposal rates for decommissioning is as stated in your current cost estimate.
2. In response to question four you state that Standby Trust Agreement contains personal information. As it does not appear to contain any personal information, please describe what personal information is contained in this document that we may have overlooked.
3. You used the words Proprietary on the front page of the Decommissioning Funding Plan, the Las Vegas and Lubbock cost estimate uses the term Confidential. If a submittal is considered as proprietary by the licensee, the licensee must submit an affidavit as required by 10 CFR 2.390. Licensees are encouraged to not submit proprietary information as proprietary information should not be needed to complete financial assurance. Please confirm that the submitted information may be released publically. Alternately, please submit an affidavit or request for the material to be returned or destroyed.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 586463. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter, facsimile (610-337-5269), or signed letter attached to an email.
