STATE OF VERMONT’S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY

NOW COMES the State of Vermont (“State”), through the Vermont Department of Public Service, with the following supplement to its supporting evidence in the above-captioned proceeding currently before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (“ASLB”). On June 23, 2015, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) published in the Federal Register an issuance of exemptions in response to a January 6, 2015 request from Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (“Entergy”).¹ The Federal Register notice is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. The notice is relevant to the Board’s question about “[t]he timeline for the exemption request,”² and to the State’s position regarding what NRC regulations would apply to Entergy or would replace the current license condition if the instant license amendment request is granted.
