In support of your request to add Drs. Bobba and Bernard currently listed as authorized users on a permit in California, please submit the following:

1. Documentation to show that they are licensed to practice medicine in the NRC states where they will be authorized users.
2. Signature of senior management to endorse their addition to the NRC license.
