On May 27, 2015, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2. The NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. F. Madden, Director, External Affairs, and other members of your staff. The inspectors documented the results of this inspection in the enclosed inspection report.

The NRC inspectors documented three findings of very low security significance (Green) in this report. These findings involved violations of NRC requirements.

If you contest the violations or significance of the non-cited violations, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001, with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region IV; the Director, Office of Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC resident inspectors at the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant.

Two cross-cutting aspects were assigned to the findings in the areas of human performance, change management [H.3] and consistent process [H.13]. If you disagree with the cross-cutting aspect assignments in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with a basis for your disagreement to the Regional Administrator, Region IV, and the NRC resident inspectors at the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant.
