Enclosed is an application (XSNM3697/01), dated June 15, 2015, recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from AREVA Inc., requesting Amendment No. 1 to export license XSNM3697. The license presently authorizes the export of natural and low-enriched uranium (LEU), first to Germany for fuel fabrication and then for ultimate use as fuel in various nuclear power reactors within EURATOM, including, but not limited to, the Olkiluoto Nuclear Power Plant (Unit 1) in Finland.


The purpose of this amendment is to: 1) reflect the applicant's name change from AREVA NP Inc. to AREVA Inc., 2) change the address of the existing intermediate consignee in Germany, and include an intermediate consignee in France, 3) increase the quantity of Uranium authorized for export from 77,464 kilograms (kg) to 200,000 kg (U-235 isotope remains the same at 3,873 kg) to increase the enrichment from 5% to approximately 2%, 4) change the licensee point of contact, and 5) extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2015 to December 31, 2021.
