SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE JULY 16, 2015, PUBLIC TELECONFERENCE
MEETING TO DISCUSS OPEN ITEMS AND OUTSTANDING ISSUES
RELATED TO THE NUCLEAR INNOVATION NORTH AMERICA, LLC.,
SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT, UNITS 3 AND 4, COMBINED LICENSE
APPLICATION

On July 16, 2015, a Category 1 public teleconference was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of Nuclear Innovation North America, LLC. (NINA). The meeting notice was issued on July 6, 2015, and was documented in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under accession number ML15188A026. The purpose of this meeting was for the NRC staff and NINA to discuss, ask questions, or note concerns regarding relevant licensing and technical issues of the South Texas Project (STP), Units 3 and 4, combined license application. A list of attendees is provided as an enclosure.

The following topics were discussed, followed by its outcome:

STP, Units 1 and 2, Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) Information:

The staff has received the draft evaluation of STP, Units 1 and 2, ISFSI dose to STP, Units 3 and 4, construction workers and have no comments. NINA will submit this evaluation to support the completion of the Chapter 12 safety evaluation. No further action.

Indemnity:

The staff has prepared a draft of the indemnity agreement amendment to react to the American Nuclear Industries letter dated July 1, 2015, that addresses the STP, Units 3 and 4, coverage. The project will share a copy of this draft with NINA for any necessary actions or questions that NINA or STP Nuclear Operating Company may have. NINA also provided a summary history of the STP, Units 1 and 2, indemnity agreement amendments. This information will be shared with the technical reviewer(s).

Transportation Security Plan:

To complete the evaluation regarding transportation security of special nuclear material, the staff will impose a license condition that requires a revision to the final safety analysis report that would include the implementation of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* 73.67 program 90-days before receipt of new fuel, the explicit use of a licensed transport entity to transport fuel, inspection of tamper indication seals and containers of fuel upon receipt, and upon fuel receipt an updating the nuclear material database within ten days while in parallel sending such notification to the shipper to convey the details of the fuel received. This time-line is to allow sufficient time for the NRC to inspect the adequacy of the program to minimize the potential for violation. The applicant considers this amenable.
