


NRC Regulatory Authority

Diablo Canyon Power Plant License Renewal

- Diablo Canyon license renewal application received on November 24, 2009
- The current operating licenses expire:
 - November 2, 2024 (Unit 1)
 - August 26, 2025 (Unit 2)



Status of the NRC Staff's Review

- Review delayed May 2011
- Safety Review
 - Safety evaluation report issued June 2, 2011
- Environmental Review
 - First environmental scoping period competed April 12, 2010



Steps to be Completed

- NRC's Safety Review
 - Safety evaluation report supplement
 - Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards
- NRC's Environmental Review
 - Supplemental environmental impact statement
- Hearing process

Environmental Review

- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)
- NRC's environmental regulations
 - 10 CFR Part 51
- NRC staff's evaluation
 - Generic environmental impact statement (GEIS)
 - Site-specific supplemental environmental impact statement (SEIS)



Environmental Impact Statement

Analyze impacts to:

- Wildlife and fish
- Water and air resources
- Historical or cultural resources
- Taxes, community development environmental justice
- Human health
- Land use
- Cumulative impacts
