I am writing in response to your letter to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated June 29, 2015, in which you informed the NRC of the temporary interruption in the pumping at Trench 2 at the Shiprock, New Mexico, Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act site (Agencywide Document Access and Management System Accession Number ML15190A356). Based on our review of your letter, we do not have any questions or comments at this time. Please inform the NRC, in writing, when the pumping resumes. In addition, if the interruption is expected to last longer than 60 days, please inform the NRC, in writing, as soon as it is determined that the interruption is expected to last more than 60 days.
