
Enclosed for your information is a copy of a notice which has been published in the Federal Register.

The notice relates to an application filed by Duke Power Company, Charlotte, North Carolina, for authorization to construct and operate a nuclear power plant at the applicant's Oconee site in eastern Oconee County near Seneca, South Carolina. The proposed nuclear power plant will consist of two pressurized water reactors, designated as the Oconee Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2, each of which is designed to operate initially at 2492 thermal megawatts with a net electrical output of 839 megawatts.

The Oconee Station Units 1 and 2 are scheduled for completion in May 1971 and May 1972, respectively.


