

**DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS ON
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT [ORDER] UNDER
THE ECONOMY ACT (31 U.S.C. 1535 and 1536)**

IAA NUMBER: NRC-HQ-11-15-I-0018

PROJECT TITLE: Defense Information Systems Network (DISN)
Secret Internet Protocol Router Network (SIPRnet)

PURPOSE: Transfer of Classified Information

AUTHORITY: THE ECONOMY ACT (31 U.S.C. 1535 and 1536)

DETERMINATION

1. I reviewed the requirement to provide funds to Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) as an Interagency Agreement (IAA) under The Economy Act (31 U.S.C. 1535 and 1536) to purchase services through the secure SIPRNet Communications Network.
2. The use of an interagency agreement is in the Government's best interest to obtain the described supplies under The Economy Act. The supplies cannot be provided as conveniently or economically by contracting directly with a private source.

FINDINGS

1. The proposed Interagency Agreement is authorized under the authority of The Economy Act (31 U.S.C. 1535 and 1536).
2. DISA has the unique expertise and capabilities to enter into the assistance agreement not currently available within the NRC.
3. The supplies or services are clearly within the scope of activities of the NRC.
4. All approvals and authorizations required by NRC policies for acquiring the supplies have been obtained.
5. The total estimated cost of the agreement is \$116,916.12. Based on previous negotiated IAA NSR-04-500, the Contract Specialist (CS) has determined the prices to be fair and reasonable.
6. The servicing agency is specifically authorized by law or regulation to purchase such supplies or services on behalf of other agencies.


Given the findings outlined above, I hereby determine that, under the authority of The Economy Act, the servicing agency DISA is authorized to provide this service on behalf of the NRC. It is in the best interest of the Government to enter into an Interagency Agreement with DISA and to provide funding to support the required service for a period beginning July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020 and funding for the first year of \$15,711.16, and an estimated monthly amount of \$1,306.26.
