SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE JULY 28, 2015, PUBLIC TELECONFERENCE
MEETING TO DISCUSS OPEN ITEMS AND OUTSTANDING ISSUES
RELATED TO THE NUCLEAR INNOVATION NORTH AMERICA, LLC.,
SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT, UNITS 3 AND 4, COMBINED LICENSE
APPLICATION

On July 28, 2015, a Category 1 public teleconference was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of Nuclear Innovation North America, LLC. (NINA). The meeting notice was issued on July 16, 2015, and was documented in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under accession number ML15202A120. The purpose of this meeting was for the NRC staff and NINA to discuss, ask questions, or note concerns regarding relevant licensing and technical issues of the South Texas Project (STP), Units 3 and 4, combined license application. A list of attendees is provided as an enclosure.

The following topics were discussed, followed by its outcome:

Indemnity

Various issues associated with indemnity were discussed, including deferred premium and information needed for the indemnity agreement to include all four STP units. With respect to secondary insurance, NINA will consider several options, including using parent company as the responsible entity for this future premium. NINA will propose license conditions for consideration to ensure payment of the deferred premium. This information will be available for the next meeting. The staff will continue to complete the indemnity agreement amendment and will need updated information on all the owners. This amendment is not required for the STP, Units 3 and 4, licensing finding.

Decommissioning Funding

Because NINA is adopting the sinking fund method to address decommissioning funding, the staff needs additional information on how NINA can satisfy the Texas statutes. Draft request for additional information questions will be prepared and provided to NINA for action. This discussion will continue during the next teleconference.
