On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter of July 7, 2015, asking whether the NRC has any information regarding radioactive waste disposal in Ellenville, NY during the 1940's and 1950's. As you noted in your letter, this activity occurred during the time when the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) was in existence; the NRC was established in 1974 and began operation in 1975.

The NRC staff in our headquarters and Region I offices are unfamiliar with the Channel Master/Schrade Knife facility in Ellenville and have no records containing the type of information you seek. It is possible that the U.S. Department of Energy may have some relevant information from the AEC's Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program, which it assumed as the other successor agency to the AEC. Also, a copy of your letter has been forwarded to the NRC's Office of the Inspector General for information.
