***“Regulatory Issue Summary: Review and Submission of Updates to Final Safety Analysis Reports, Emergency Planning and Fire Protection Documents”***

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# Purpose and Scope

The Purpose and Scope of the Proposed Regulatory Information Summary (RIS) Include:

- Updates to Final Safety Analysis Reports (FSARs), Emergency Preparedness and Fire Protection Documents
  - Remind licensees of the requirements in 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1)
- FSAR Updates
  - Recommend that licensees voluntarily submit updates to the FSAR electronically (via CD or Electronic Information Exchange (EIE)) on a total replacement basis.

# Approach

- Regulatory Requirements
  - 10 CFR 2.390 information review and marking requirements apply to physical protection information.
  - Licensees have two submission options for FSAR updates:
    - Electronically on a total replacement basis (10 CFR 50.4(b)(6)), or
    - Paper replacement page basis (10 CFR 50.71(e)).
- Staff Proposal
  - Submission on a total replacement basis will decrease staff hours required to reconstruct the FSAR for licensing action reviews, and assist the NRC in its emergency response function by ensuring that recently-updated, full FSARs are available.

# Next Steps

- NRC's Generic Communication Development Process will be Followed:
  - Release of draft RIS for 30-day public comment period
  - Address public comments
  - Finalize and release RIS
  - Separately, conduct public workshop with industry to ensure consistency in addressing:
    - Redaction methods
    - Identification of physical protection information
