DVA's second submittal, dated June 25, 2015, for proposed revisions to SOP-04 "NHPP inspector/permit reviewer qualifications"

SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUIRED (IF ANY)

I contacted Jeff in follow-up to our previous discussion about the DVA's proposed revisions to SOP-04. In March, Jeff and I spoke about the DVA's initial request for NRC approval of equivalent training courses for some NRC core training for inspectors and reviewers that is described in IMC 1248.

On March 19, 2015, I communicated NRC's concerns over the proposal to Craig Adams. As a result, Mr. Adams revised and resubmitted his request on June 25, 2015. On July 20, 2015, I spoke with Jeff Griffis of the NRC's TTC office and he agreed that the DVA's proposed board certifications described in Mr. Adam's June 25 letter were acceptable as equivalent to the NRC's courses H-201, H-304, and H-313. However, Jeff felt that Mr. Adams' proposed vendor-provided equivalent training for H-201 did not adequately match the H-201 course content. For example, the two 40 hour courses offered by ORAU did not include line, point, or area sources, and internal dosimetry.

I spoke with Bob Prince of the NRC TTC office about Mr. Adams' request for NRC acceptance of a transportation course taught by Nevada Technical Associates as equivalent to NRC's H-308 course. Mr Prince was familiar with the vendor and looked at the course content and stated that the vendors training would be equivalent to the NRC's H-308 course, and an acceptable substitution for the NRC course.

Regarding substituting the TapRoot course for the NRC's root cause course G-205, I informed Mr. Adams that this course was found to be an acceptable substitution when the MML was initially issued.

On July 20, 2015, I contacted Tom Huston, who was acting for Craig Adams, about the above and informed him that the NHPP would need to resubmit SOP-04 and delete their proposed vendor-provided equivalent training for HP-201, and the amendment request would be accepted and an amendment to the license would be issued.


