Dear Mr. Ramos:

On August 16, 2013- July 8, 2015, the NRC Region I office conducted a safety inspection at Doral Bank Plaza, San Juan, Puerto Rico of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The findings of the inspection were discussed by Mr. Craig Gordon with you at the conclusion of the inspection.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified.

Your license expired February 28, 2014, after being amended for storage-only of licensed material. In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 30.36, the facility must be decommissioned, including transfer of all material by February 28, 2016. In recent discussions with Mr. Gordon, you stated that you are actively working with officials in the Dominican Republic to transfer the last amount of licensed material (contained in a calibration device) in your possession. Please keep us apprised of your progress regarding transfer of the device. The NRC can terminate your license following documentation (including shipping and receipt records) that material was properly transferred.
