SUBJECT: RETIREMENT OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 25-27800-01

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received Rocky Boy Health Board notification dated April 17, 2015 stating that the licensee was no longer in possession of material authorized under NRC license 25-27800-01. This license expired on February 28, 2015.

The NRC staff has reviewed the historical docket file, and the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility. The leak test result documents that there was no evidence of leakage of radioactive material from the sealed sources under your possession. Your facility located at 10 miles east of Box Elder, on Oats Road, at the old post plant building, Box Elder, Montana, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." No further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 03 to License No. 25-27800-01 retiring this license. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
