
RE: Transfer of Device Containing Radioactive Material

Dear Mr. Paperiello:

This letter constitutes the notice required under 10 C.F.R. 31.5(c)(9) for transfer of measuring, gauging, or controlling devices containing radioactive material. Hartford City Paper LLC currently holds a general license to possess radioactive materials at its Hartford City, Indiana facility. Pursuant to that certain Purchase and Sale Agreement by and between Hartford City Paper LLC and New Indy Containerboard dated June 30, 2015, Hartford City Paper LLC has agreed to transfer ownership of its facility in Hartford City, Indiana to New Indy Hartford City LLC as of June 30, 2015. As part of that transaction, a gauging device identified as an AccuRay, Model 0-7, Serial Number K-1199-G, will be transferred to New Indy Containerboard. ABB Industrial Systems, Inc., the manufacturer of the device, has informed us that the AccuRay contains a sensor with 250 microcuries of Krypton 85.
