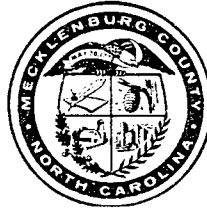



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mecklenburg County Board of County Commissioners makes the following requests for inclusion in the new Department of Transportation regulations:

- 1) The U. S. Department of Transportation should allow the Chief of Police of Mecklenburg County input in the selection of routes for the shipment of large quantity packages.
- 2) The Chief of Police of Mecklenburg County should be allowed to suggest reasonable times of day or night for the shipment of large quantity radioactive material through urban areas.
- 3) Shippers of large quantity shipments should be required to provide advance notification to the Chief of Police of Mecklenburg County when transport through Charlotte-Mecklenburg is contemplated.
